## RIMINI FIERA, COUNTDOWN FOR THE GREEN ECONOMY'S HUGE INTERNATIONAL EXPO HUB

From 6th to 9th November, a thousand companies will fill sixteen halls, occupied simultaneously by ECOMONDO, KEY ENERGY, KEY WIND, SALVE, H2R and COOPERAMBIENTE

From 6th to 9th November, over a thousand companies, key players of the green economy, will welcome to Rimini Fiera over 85,000 Italian and foreign trade members interested in discovering the latest products and technology useful for sustainable development.

With less than two months to go, the range of products and services on show is already defined, as well as the new features prepared for this edition. The expo layout will occupy all 16 halls of the expo centre, as well as the centre foyer with the new H2R project on sustainable mobility and some outdoor areas for test drives, with the most innovative models of cars to which the visitors and exhibitors will have access. The brands at the expo are really important, acknowledging the Rimini event's leadership in the sector.

But let's proceed in an orderly manner. One of the new features of the 2013 edition is precisely the debut at Rimini Fiera of H2R Mobility for Sustainability (Hall South Foyer), the sustainable car expo resulting from the strategic partnership between Rimini Fiera and H2Roma, which thus moves to the Rimini expo centre with an exclusive prestigious combination of research, industry and institutions, ideal for discovering innovative technologies and solutions useful for reducing traffic circulation's environmental impact.

At H2R, brands awaited include Mercedes, Fiat, Nissan, Ford, BMW, Volvo Renault and others, as well as ENAL technologies for charging stations. Test drives with 30 cars, open to visitors and exhibiting companies, are scheduled, as well as meetings and advance news on the new frontiers in research.

Another important new feature is the return of the SAL.VE triennial waste vehicle expo (Hall





A5), thanks to the agreement for the next nine years with the ANFIA - Italian Association of the Automotive Industry, which will favour the participation of the companies of its Waste Service Vehicle Section. The expo will feature the most technologically advanced products on the market of coachwork for urban sanitation and solid and liquid waste transport, offering visitors the possibility of discovering the most recent innovations and talking about their specific needs with the sector's top companies. These are waste service vehicles - of which compacters, waste tanks, canal jet sewage pipe and septic tank cleaning trucks and street sweepers are the main product categories - forms an excellent niche in the national manufacturing chain, which is reacting to the crisis by continuing to field innovation and quality. Participants include companies of the calibre of Farid Industrie, Giletta, Cappellotto, Ravo, Mazzocchia, AMS, Cos.Eco, Dulevo International, Nilfisk, Aebi Schnidt, Unieco, Rossi Oleodinamica, Officine Pilla, Omb, etc.

The Waste sector, the historical nucleus from which 17 years ago gave birth to the ECOMONDO project, will be hosted in Halls B1, B2, B3, B4 and D2. Here, visitors will find companies specialized in the recovery, recycling and exploitation of waste, as well as all the services for the cycle's integrated management. In Hall D2 the spotlight will be on a joint participation by a group of 30 enterprises from the Province of Trento.

In Hall D1, one of the most innovative proposals: the enterprises of the Bio Based Industry with the big players from the world of green chemistry: Novamont, ENI/Versalis, Basf, Mossi&Ghisolfi, Federchimica, Matrica, Biotec, Assobioplastica... while, in Hall D3, the space will be dedicated to the Oro Blu section, whose

participants include the GISI, with companies specialized in drinking and waste water analysis, measurement and control.

Halls D5 and B5 will be occupied by KEY ENERGY, the expo dedicated to sustainable energy and mobility. B5 will also host cooperatives involved in the green economy, brought to COOPERAMBIENTE by Legacoop. At the East entrance, Halls B7 and D7 will welcome visitors with the area dedicated to the Institutions and the large proposal of Sustainable City, with the innovative technologies required by smart cities. Here there will be meetings, reports and presentations of innovative experiences sure to attract international attendees' attention. In Hall D7, another new feature: the first edition of KEY WIND, the section dedicated to wind energy and the result of the agreement between ANEV and Rimini Fiera.

Companies from the remediation sector will be in Halls C1 and C2, whereas A1, A2, A3 and C3 will host machinery and systems for handling waste. Hall C5 will feature earthmoving machines involved in the construction trade. On show, there will be brands of the calibre of CGT Compagnia Generale Trattori, Liebherr, Volvo, Hitachi, Yakeuchi, JCB, Atlas Maschinen, Wacher Neuson, Manitou, CNH, etc. Construction Equipment Day 2013, promoted by UNACEA, is also scheduled: an annual public appointment dedicated to construction machinery (7th November). This year's program will focus on three points: economic trends, the environment and internationalization.

Lastly, Halls A7 and C7 will host the big players in the waste collection and transport field, chassis manufacturers such as Mercedes, Renault, Piaggio, Scania, Goupil, etc.
